Egypt captain Mohamed Salah smashed his penalty over the bar while facing a barrage of lasers as the Pharaohs were 7, £ on the receiving end of another shootout defeat by Senegal

Senegal fans resorted to dirty tactics in a bid to give 7, £ their country the upper hand during the crunch World Cup play-off clash versus Egypt on Tuesday - by targeting opposing 7, £ players with a shower of laser beams.

Mohamed Salah was just one of the Egyptian stars on the receiving end of 7, £ the harassment as a host of green lasers were pointed in his face at various points throughout the fixture. Goalkeeper 7, £ Mohammed El Shenawy was also a prime target for Senegal fans, who furiously shone their lasers when he was faced 7, £ with a free-kick or for each penalty in the crucial shootout.

Hamdi Fathi's own goal after just four minutes put Senegal 7, £ in front on the night and levelled the score on aggregate after Egypt had taken a one-goal lead into the 7, £ second leg at the Stade Me Abdoulaye Wade in Diamniadio. The score stayed that way until after extra time, with 7, £ the sides then forced into another shootout just months after experiencing the same scenario in the Africa Cup of Nations 7, £ final.

Again it was Senegal who emerged the victors, after a nerve-wracking finale which started off with four missed spot kicks 7, £ in a row. Even Salah could not tuck his effort away having been moved up Egypt's order after missing out 7, £ on the opportunity to take one at AFCON, this time blazing his shot over after a host of lasers were 7, £ shone in his direction in a bid to distract him. It clearly worked a treat.

Mane was Senegal's hero in Cameroon 7, £ less than two months ago by striking the spot kick which gave his country their first ever continental triumph. Once 7, £ again, he was on hand to net the winning penalty against Egypt and ensure he and his compatriots will travel 7, £ to Qatar this winter.

Senegal were worthy victors of the second leg after dominating proceedings but the occasion was marred somewhat 7, £ by the hostile atmosphere and lasers which targeted the Pharaohs. El Shenawy faced intense abuse from the stands throughout the 7, £ match and was targeted with water bottles and other missiles thrown in his direction, many of which struck him.
